This month in toddler room, we watched the process of caterpillars transforming into butterflies. Focus Activity!



The babies have enjoyed painting activities this month, they created some paintings for the Kings Coronation. Painting helps with children fine and gross motor skills as well as their hand-eye coordination. It helps to promote concentration and their spatial intelligence. Painting activities for toddlers benefit the brain and motor development. Because toddlers hold brushes to make stroke movements, and engage the muscles of their hands while they paint, they train their motor skills.

We also collected leaves and twigs so that we could bring back to nursery to create some collages with. Playing outdoors allows children to develop self-confidence, independence and self-esteem.
